Mrs. Patricia "Pat" Lynne Mohler Harris, 66, of Harmony, passed away on Wednesday, October 28, 2020 with her family by her side at Rosewood Assisted Living. Pat was born in Iredell County on February 6, 1954 and was the daughter of the late Howard Adams and Kay Fox Mohler. She was a graduate of South Iredell High School and on February 10, 1974 she married Joe Harris and together they shared 46 years of marriage before her passing.

Whether it was for clothes, or for flowers (it didn't matter what kind-she loved them all), or for craft supplies! She was an excellent craftsperson who enjoyed painting, quilting, and wreath making. Anyone that crossed her path will remember her smile and caring demeanor.

In addition to her husband, Joe, Pat is survived by one daughter, Melissa H. Whitaker (Bobby) and two sons, Billy Harris (Michelle), both of Harmony and Josh Harris of Mocksville. She is also survived by six grandchildren, Kaitlyn and Gage Marshall and Lauren, Lex, Nathan, and James Harris, all of Harmony. She is further survived by one sister, Brenda Hicks (Jim) of Olin.
